Wine can be a synthesis of some essential elements, one of which is time: More time, more history, greater quality.

Some wines transcend the natural age of man. These Sherries have undergone century long ageing in Barbadillo's old cellars, or 'bodegas', in silence, almost forgotten, and have evolved in to these vinous jewels, the Reliquias.

Upon the death of Antonio Barbadillo Ambrossy in 1921, a number of wines appeared in his will that were noted as belonging to 'the grandfather'. This referred to his grandfather Benigno Barbadillo Hortigüela who founded the winery in 1821.

These wines continued to pass down from grandfather to grandson, untouched for over 150 years, until they reached today's sixth generation. Deep mahogany in colour with attractive golden amber glints. Full deep aromas of noble oak, walnuts and dried fruits. Intense and concentrated and notably dry flavour, long and powerful on the palate with complex flavours of nuts, antique oak and dried citrus.
